

Paying Your UW-Madison Housing & Tuition Bills

You have many options when it comes to paying your housing and tuition bills to the university. Keep in mind you should complete only one of these payment options each time a bill is due, to avoid double-paying your bill.

At UW-Madison, tuition and housing charges are billed separately. The Division of University Housing will bill you only for charges related to living in the University Residence Halls. Tuition payments and billing are coordinated by the Bursar's Office.

University Housing

- 1. Pay online.** Log on to <http://www.housing.wisc.edu/billing/payment.php>. Use your NETID to log in. Students and authorized payers (parents, guardians, third party sponsors, etc.) can pay housing bills online using an electronic check (eCheck) or credit card (Mastercard, Discover or American Express). Note that UW Housing is unable to accept payments from foreign bank accounts or credit card companies.
 - a. Electronic Check** (also known as an ACH). Use your personal checking account number and UW Credit Union's routing number (2759-7907-6). This is a great option if you don't have a checkbook for your checking account. There is no additional charge for electronic check payments. **DO NOT** use the account and routing numbers off of a **cashier's check** to make a payment online.
- 2. Write a check from your checking account.** Personal checks can be sent to the Housing Cashier's Office at 625 Babcock Drive, Madison, WI 53706 or dropped off in person there. Office hours are Monday–Friday from 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- 3. Get a cashier's check.** Come to a UW Credit Union branch to order a cashier's check for the amount that's due. Mail or drop off the cashier's check to the Housing Cashier's Office at 625 Babcock Drive, Madison, WI 53706. **DO NOT** use the account and routing numbers off of your **cashier's check** to make a payment online.

Tuition & Fees—Bursar's Office

After you register for your courses, a Student Account Invoice will be generated and emailed to your wisc.edu email address. Beginning spring 2010, eBills will be UW-Madison's only tuition bill method.

Fees and tuition can be paid by check or cashier's check at the Bursar's Office, Suite 10501, in the University Square Building, located at 333 East Campus Mall.

You can also pay online with your checking account and UW Credit Union routing number (Electronic Check). **DO NOT** use the account and routing numbers off of your **cashier's check** to make a payment online.
